

5-Inch Locomotive Wins

A model locomotive, five inches long, that required two years of spare-time work to complete, won the "best in show" award yesterday in the contest held by the New York Society of Model Engineers in connection with its annual exhibition, now open to the public through Feb. 23 at the Lackawanna Terminal, Hoboken, N. J. The winning model was constructed by Ira L. Deutsch, 1917 Loring Place, the Bronx. William W. Conley, 12 East Ninth Street, won first award for a ship model.
