

MODEL BOAT QUALIFIES.

Clifton 2d to Compete for Engineers Cup in September.

Several hundred model boat racing enthusiasts who gathered yesterday morning at Conservatory Lake in Central Park saw Clifton 2d, owned by Adolph Bosshart of Clifton, N. J., win the elimination races for the right to compete in the New York Society of Model Engineers Cup race next September. Clifton 2d is the sixth boat to qualify.

Clifton 2d, a one-meter model of the Hacker 54-foot speed boats, powered with a one-cylinder gas engine, averaged slightly over twenty miles an hour over a course of about one-quarter of a mile. One of the other entrants, Cathleen 4th, owned by Fred Zimmer, averaged more than twenty-five miles an hour for the first part of the course, but broke down before she reached the end.
