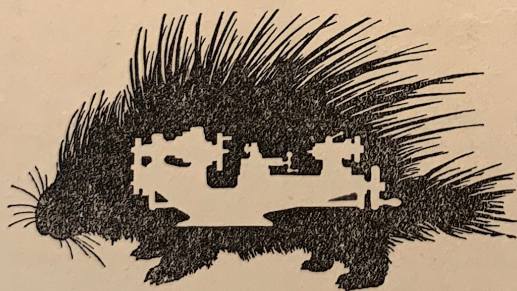
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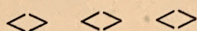

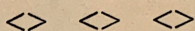
Awards and Prizes have been offered by Members and the Society for the best Models in the several Branches of Modelmaking.



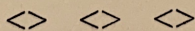
