The New York Society of Model Engineers was originated by Messrs. A. A. and T. E. R. Singer and Mr. Walter Elliott from monthly social gatherings in Messrs. Singer's office at 15 Moore Street, New York City.

The organization took place during April, 1926. Mr. Elliott took the Chair pro tem, later succeeded by Mr. F. R. Pope. Mr. A. A. Singer was elected Secretary and Treasurer. It was also decided upon to hold meetings once a month, to have the minimum amount of Business and Routine Transactions, and the Meetings to be most informal.

In March, 1927, the New York Society of Model Engineers voted upon holding their meetings in the United Engineering Societies Building at 29 West 39th Street, New York City. And this was also chosen for the official address for the Society.

In 1926 the question of holding an Exhibition was taken up.

In 1927 arrangements were made, but through an error in booking, the Exhibition was given up. And now, through the kindness of Mr. F. J. Dobler in obtaining a suitable place, it is possible for the Society to hold the First Annual Exhibit.
